

PLANNING APPLICATIONS IN COATES PARISH

All Planning Applications within the area covered by Coates Parish Council are submitted to Cotswold District Council (CDC) for consideration. CDC is responsible for making decisions on all Planning Applications in Coates Parish and can approve, reject or modify any application.

As part of its consideration, CDC refer all Planning Applications in Coates Parish to Coates Parish Council for comment. Coates Parish Council normally has 21 days to comment on Planning Applications referred to it, and any comments made within this time period are considered by CDC. Comments made by Coates Parish Council are based on Parishioners views. In order that these views are understood and communicated within the 21 days required, it is important that those views are made to Coates Parish Council in a timely manner.

Parishioners can send their views or comments on any matter, including Planning Applications, to Parish Councillors or the Parish Council Clerk by email, telephone or in person. Contact details are on the Parish Council website (www.coatesparish.org.uk) or call the Clerk on 01285 641375.

Parishioners who send comments on Planning Applications to Coates Parish Council may also wish to send comments to CDC. Whilst encouraged to send comments to Coates Parish Council it is not an obligation in order to send comments directly to CDC.
